<p>History Bee</p> <p>World History Bee</p> <p>International Geo Bee</p>	<p>https://nationalhistorybee.com/fall-2020-online-bee-leagues/</p>	<p>These are run through International Academic Competitions (IAC)</p> <p>The cost is \$30 per student/per 'League'</p> <p>-Registering for a 'league' guarantees a student to play three one-hour matches.</p> <p>-Matches occur once a week.</p> <p>-ISC will run leagues in Oct., Jan., and Feb., and a separate registration is required for each 'league.'</p> <p>The Geo leagues are leveled for middle school.</p> <p>The History Bees are leveled for high school and middle school students can register for high school Junior Varsity.</p>

This year's prompt asks students to reflect on Holocaust history and create a piece of writing or work of visual art that considers the role that laws played in the discrimination against and persecution and genocide of Jewish people, and the importance of civic responsibility and engagement. The two Grand Prize winners – one for art and the other for writing – will win a trip to Washington D.C. to visit the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum for themselves, a guardian, and their teacher!
