

## \*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\* Forecasting Instructions

- Use the Lakeridge website to find course descriptions and new class offerings (www.losdschools.org/lhs > Academics (top menu bar) > Curriculum Guide)
- Certain classes will be automatically entered, but can be changed by your counselor when you meet with them individually
- Forecast for Health and PE if needed
- Pick at least **4 alternates** in case your first choice electives aren't available
- Math and Science classes will be added automatically only for current 8<sup>th</sup> graders
- Band students will forecast for Symphonic Band – adjustments will be made after auditions
- Orchestra students will forecast for Philharmonic Orchestra – adjustments will be made after auditions
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade students can forecast for Treble or Pacer Choir
- All other students interested in taking Choir will forecast for Concert Choir and adjustments will be made after auditions
- If you are auditioning for Company, also forecast for the class you will take if not selected for Company and let your counselor know
- If you are running for student government, forecast for the class you will take if not elected and let your counselor know
- **All students** need to be enrolled in a minimum of **6 classes per semester**
- Make sure you have accounted for all 8 periods for both semesters in your forecast
- For year-long classes, you must add both semesters S1 and S2
- You will have an individual meeting with your counselor to answer your questions. **Do not sign up to see your counselor** for forecasting questions before the end of March

## Graduation Requirements for LOSD

Fine Arts – 1 credit

English – 4 credits

Science – 3 credits\*

World Language – 2 credits

Health – 1 credit (½ credit in grade 9 or 10 and ½ credit in grade 11 or 12)

Physical Education – 1 credit (½ credit of PE in grade 9 or 10 and ½ credit of another PE class at any time)

Adv. Communication – ½ credit

Mathematics – 3 credits (Algebra and above)

Social Studies – 3 credits

Electives – 6½ credits

\*Science credits for the Class of 2023 and later must include:

1 credit Earth & Space Science (Geoscience or AP Environmental Science)

1 credit Life Science (Biology)

1 credit Physical Science (1 semester Physics and 1 semester Chemistry)
