### **KEY REMINDERS:**

- ★ Forecast for at least 7 credited classes (not including late arrival or early release)
- **★** DO NOT FORECAST for
  - Dept. Assistant, Independent Study, Work Experience or Leadership (but you can forecast for *Link Crew* Leadership)
- ★ APPLICATION CLASSES-
  - Go ahead and forecast for any classes that require an application or audition (course determination & placements will be made in spring).
  - All applications can be found on the high school's website, under the **"FORECASTING INFORMATION" icon**.

### **AUDITION CLASSES:**

- ★ Band: If taking a band class, forecast for **Symphonic Band**, audition, and schedule adjustments will be made based on teacher placement.
- ★ If you would like to take **Jazz Band** forecast for that as well, separately.
- ★ Orchestra: If taking an orchestra course, forecast for **Symphony Orchestra**, audition, and schedule adjustments will be made based on teacher placement.
- ★ Choir: If taking a choir class, forecast for **A Cappella**, audition, and schedule adjustments will be made based on teacher placement.

**SENIORS (to be):** If interested in applying to University of California colleges be sure you have 2 consecutive years of art. (**Example:** Acting 1 & Acting 2 or Ceramics & Advanced Ceramics or Art 1 & Art 2)
