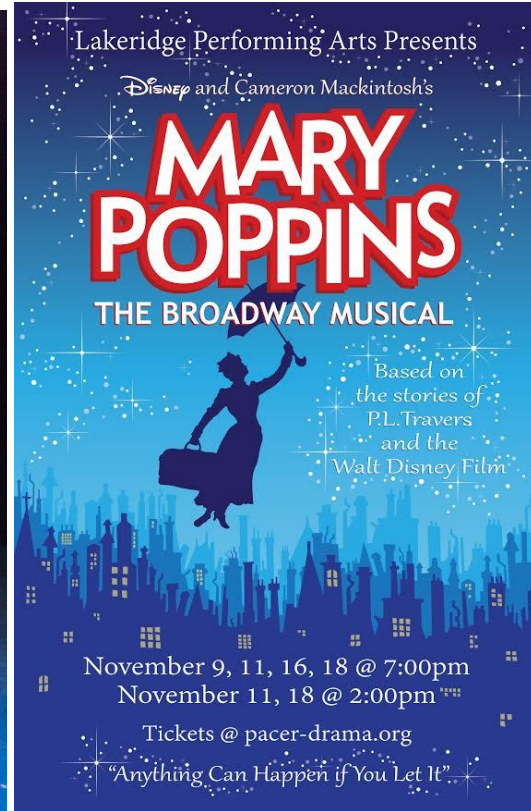

Free Practice ACT at Lakeridge High School

Saturday, January 6, 2018, 9:00 a.m.

The Princeton Review will administer a free, practice ACT test in the Lakeridge High School cafeteria on Saturday, January 6, 2018 at 9:00 a.m.. Students can take a full-length practice test under realistic testing conditions. After the test, they'll get a personalized score report highlighting strengths and areas for improvement.

The Princeton Review return to Lakeridge High School for an ACT "Strategy Session" on Wednesday, January 17, 2018 at 6:30 p.m.. They will help students understand their score reports, explain how standardized tests fit into the college admissions process, and teach score-raising strategies to help students become savvy test-takers.
