“The Mask You Live In” Viewing

The Lake Oswego chapter of National League of Young Men, with generous cooperation from The Lake Theater, is offering a free showing of the film “The Mask You Live In” on Sunday, January 7 at 7:00pm at The Lake Theater. This film follows boys and young men as they struggle to stay true to themselves while negotiating America’s narrow definition of masculinity. Pressured by the media, their peer groups, and even the adults in their lives, the films protagonists confront messages encouraging them to disconnect from their emotions, devalue authentic friendships, objectify women, and resolve conflicts through violence. These gender stereotypes interconnect with race, class, and circumstance, creating a maze of identity issues boys and young men must navigate to become “real men”. Experts in neuroscience, psychology, sociology, sports, education and media also weigh in, offering empirical evidence and tactics for change. “The Mask You Live In” ultimately illustrates how we, as a society, can do better to raise a healthier generation of boys and young men.

National League of Young Men is an organization for mothers and high school aged sons that promotes the development of young men into community leaders through leadership involvement, charitable and community service, cultural experiences and protocol education.

Student scores will be available online on Monday, December 11th.

Log in to an existing College Board account, or create a new one at:

studentscores.collegeboard.org

1. Log in to your account.
2. Select PSAT/NMSQT Scores.

OR

3. Use “Missing Scores” to locate scores.

Test scores, cross-test scores, and subscores give students specific information about their strengths and areas for improvement. When students get scores on December 11th, they can go to satpractice.org to create a free account with personalized recommendations for improvement based on their PSAT results.

PORTLAND FBI YOUTH ACADEMY

Portland FBI will be hosting a five day, four night Youth Academy.
