

Last day of School and 8th Grade Celebration Info

Adjustments have been made to our plan for the last day of school (now a full-length day). As always, we are excited to celebrate the end of the year with our all-student formal awards recognition assembly, the 8th grade celebration field trip, and 8th grade clap-out. All of these events will take place on June 7th.

Because of capacity constraints, we cannot accommodate parent attendance at our formal awards assembly that morning though we will make sure to publish the names of all students honored in the assembly.

After the assembly, 8th Graders will board busses for their 8th grade celebration field trip to Oaks Park (approximately 10:30 AM). They will return to school between 3 and 3:30 for their final assembly as middle schoolers. While we are assembled, 8th grade parents and 6th and 7th grade students will line the halls and walkways throughout campus. When the 8th graders exit the assembly they will symbolically walk the halls for a final time to the applause of the entire school community to commemorate their years here. The walk will end in the main gym where administration from LHS will welcome them, share words of encouragement and congratulations, and send them into the summer as newly minted Lakeridge High School Pacers.
